- 1. You agree on behalf of yourself and the driver to observe all circuit/track rules and regulations and all instructions given AAB.
- 2. You agree on behalf of yourself and the driver to observe and comply with any advice, instruction, request or decision made by us whether on the grounds of the safety of the driver or any other person or for any other reason at all.
- 3. You agree on behalf of yourself and the driver that our opinion on all matters regarding safety will be final.
- 4. You agree on behalf of yourself and the driver that any driver acting in a manner which, in our opinion, is dangerous or may interfere with or disrupt the experience, we will at our sole discretion and without further liability to us immediately have the experience terminated without refund.

Rules & Regulations

1. Promoter: Automobile Association of Bangladesh

2) Type of Events: Karting Slalom

3) Venue: Auditorium & Car Parking, SCBA

4) Date: 08 & 09 March, 2024

5) Timetable: Day 01 08 March - Sign on: 03:45 PM Day 02 09 March - Sign on: 09:45 AM

6) Jurisdiction: This event will be held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary regulations and any written instructions the promoting club may issue for the event.

7) Eligible Competitors:

Members of the Automobile Association of Bangladesh, or members of the public applying to compete in the event at the digression of the COC

8) Tests: Dependent on time and number of competitors, each event will run between 1 and 2 tests.

Competitors will have two attempts at each test, both attempts will be timed. Each competitor's worst

Performance at each test will be discarded in arriving at the total penalties for the event. Details of

- 9) Timing apparatus Stop watch operated by the timekeeper
- 10) Vehicles will be supplied by the Automobile Association of Bangladesh will be the only vehicle eligible to compete in the tests.
- 11) Starts: When ready the competitor will be asked to start when ready. The timekeeper will



Start the clock when the competitor starts.

- 12) Finish: Will occur when the vehicle stops within the allocated "finish box". Failure to stop at the stop control will result in a missed control penalty.
- 13) Penalties: Striking of any barrier or cone = 1 second pen

Missing a control test control = 5 second penalty

Not performing a test correctly (wrong direction, not completing test or false start) = 20 second penalty

- 14) All competitors must wear approved clothing items as supplied by the Automobile Association of Bangladesh, not limited to: Crash Helmet, Karting Race Suit, Gloves. Additionally, the competitor must wear closed toe shoes
- 15) Entries: Competitors must register their interest to compete at the documentation area on the day of the event. A signed disclaimer form must be completed to be eligible to enter.
- 16) Officials: Automobile Association of Bangladesh will provide officials for the event: Clerk of the Course, Steward, Secretary of the Meeting and Timekeeper. Details of these officials will be issued prior to the event.
- 17) Results: Will be posted at the venue during the event and an official prize giving ceremony after all race activity is completed.
