

**Application for an International Driving Permit [IDP]** 



## NOTES AND REQUIREMENTS

An International Driving Permit (IDP) is legally recognised translation of the holder's national driving licence which allows the holder to drive a motor vehicle of the specified class outside his own country. IDPs are issued under the Convention on Road Traffic 1949 to which Bangladesh is a signatory.

The Federation International de l'Automobile (FIA) and its member clubs, including the Automobile Association of Bangladesh (AA Bangladesh) are authorised by international law to issue IDP.

### **Requirements:**

- 1. The application should be filled up in capital as per BRTA Licence.
- 2. BRTA Licence photocopy with at least one month validity on the date of application.
- 3. If BRTA Driving Licence is issued from outside Mirpur BRTA (DM1), then the photocopy of Driving Licence must be attested

by the issuing BRTA authority.

- 4. NID photocopy.
- 5. Passport information page photocopy.
- 6. Photograph 4 copy stamp size & 1 copy passport size.
